## Medicare Guidelines for Group Therapy: Speech-Language ...

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Group Therapy Documentation Requirements The following documentation must be maintained in the client's medical record: Prescribing provider's prescription for group therapy. Individualized treatment plan that includes frequency and duration of the prescribed group therapy and individualized treatment goals.

## **Group Therapy Documentation Requirements**

Administrative colleagues in clinic or managed care settings provide tangible physical resources that are required of therapy groups and sometimes intangible institutional support for the group or program. Each of these two groups (clients and colleagues) requires preparation and education by the therapist.

The official document, based on the Framework, describes the components and purpose of professional documentation used in occupational therapy. AOTA advocates for fair coverage and payment policies for occupational therapy practitioners by public and private health insurers and organizations that provide referrals to—and payment for—occupational therapy services.

## **Guidelines for Documentation of Occupational Therapy**

It is critical that therapists demonstrate that the delivery of Group Therapy services is truly what is clinically indicated and necessary to achieve desired outcomes. Documentation should include objectives, expected benefits, the patient's response (and carryover) to the group treatment, as well as plans for follow-up/next steps.

## **Group Therapy Under PDPM: Strength in Numbers**

1. Develop and implement a solid medical record documentation policy if there is not one in place, even if you are a practitioner in a solo practice. If there is one in place, make sure the policy covers meeting Federal and State Medicaid regulations. The policy should address what actually happens

## **Guidelines for Documentation of Occupational Therapy**

Under the new rule, the use of concurrent and group therapy must include detailed justification in the resident's plan of care (therapy evaluation), including: The specific benefits to that particular patient for the use of concurrent or group therapy and the specific amount of therapy and discipline to receive.

group therapy session typically lasts 45 to 60 minutes. Personal group dynamics are discussed and explored in a therapeutic setting allowing emotional catharsis, instruction, insight, and support. Group therapy, since it involves psychotherapy, must be led by a person who is licensed or otherwise authorized
